

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING
POLICE PENSION FUND ORDINANCE NO. 822

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Ordinance No. 822 establishing a Police Pension Fund, providing for a Pension Trust Committee, a Pension Trustee, and providing for a Pension Trust Indenture is amended as follows:

Section 1. Article II, Section 4 (a) is amended to read as follows:

- (a) Twenty-Five years of aggregate and continuous service in the Borough as a policeman age 55 or ...

Section 2. Article II, Section 4 (e) shall be amended by the substitution of the following for the third paragraph thereof:

Further, any member of the police force who has been employed as a full time regular policeman for a period of at least six (6) months and who thereafter shall enter into the military service of the United States by conscription or in lieu of conscription shall have credited to his employment record for pension or retirement benefits all the time spent by him for the duration of such compulsory military obligation only, if such person returns or has heretofore returned to his employment as a regular full time policeman within six (6) months after his separation from the service.
