

ORDINANCE NO. 922

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 479, FIXING THE WAGES, SALARIES, VACATIONS AND SICK LEAVE OF BOROUGH OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT, PROMOTION AND DISCHARGE THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Article II of said Ordinance No. 479 is amended to include as follows, effective May 1, 1975:

Section 1. Certain general employees of the Borough of Monroeville performing municipal service duties shall be classified as follows, and their compensation shall be in steps based upon experience and performance as established by grade and compensation schedule as set forth in Section 2 below:

Section 2. Section 1 of Article II of said Ordinance No. 479 is amended as follows:
