

ORDINANCE NO. 957

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS TO
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LUCCHINO, GAITENS
& HOUGH (THOMAS H. HOUGH, ESQ.) FOR THE
PURPOSE OF THEIR ACTING AS A COLLECTIVE
BARGAINING REPRESENTATIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville
in Council assembled as follows:

SECTION I. That the appropriate officials of the Borough
of Monroeville are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with
Lucchino, Gaitens & Hough (Thomas H. Hough, Esq.) for the purpose
of their acting as a collective bargaining representative.

SECTION II. That the contract is hereby approved and ratified
and a copy of said contract is attached hereto and made a part hereof
and marked Exhibit "A".

EXHIBIT "A"

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into between THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE and LUCCHINO, GAITENS & HOUGH (THOMAS H. HOUGH, ESQ.),

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS the Borough of Monroeville is in need of acquiring a professional labor negotiator for its collective bargaining negotiations; and

WHEREAS Thomas H. Hough, Esq. has represented himself to be experienced in labor matters and collective bargaining;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Thomas H. Hough, Esq. shall perform all necessary services in connection with the Borough's labor relation matters, including but not limited to the collective bargaining process as prescribed in its Acts 111 and 195.
- 2. The Borough of Monroeville shall pay to Thomas H. Hough, Esq. the sum of FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS per hour, which shall be inclusive of all auxiliary charges such as clerical, secretarial and office expenses.
- 3. The total amount paid by the Borough shall not exceed TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000.00) DOLLARS, unless otherwise approved by Borough Council.
- 4. Bills shall be submitted on a monthly basis and approved by Council in accordance with the manner provided for the payment of Borough obligations.
- 5. Thomas H. Hough, Esq. shall be available for the purposes herein set forth at all reasonable times, provided reasonable notice is given by the Borough of Monroeville.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The Borough of Monroeville (called the Borough herein) and Thomas H. M. Hough, of Lucchino, Gaitens & Hough (called personnel attorney herein) agree to the following for the period commencing August 12, 1975.

1. For all necessary services performed by the personnel attorney in connection with the district's labor relations responsibilities, including but not limited to the collective bargaining process as prescribed in Acts 111 and 195, the district shall pay \$50.00 per hour charged. This charge shall be inclusive of all auxiliary charges such as normal clerical, secretarial, and office charges.
2. The limit of payment per year shall be \$2,000.00 unless otherwise approved by Council.
3. Bills shall be submitted and paid monthly.
4. Personnel attorney agrees to hold himself reasonably available to perform the above services.
