

ORDINANCE NO. 963

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING
ORDINANCES 868 AND 636, ESTABLISHING PERMIT FEES FOR
CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Borough of Monroeville in Council
assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of the aforementioned Ordinances shall be amended
to include the following subsections:

- l) For all new pool installations ----\$10.00
- m) For all new fence installations ---\$10.00
- n) For all new shed installations ----\$10.00

SECTION 2. Section 4 of the aforesaid Ordinances shall be amended to
read as follows:

APPLICATIONS FOR PROCEEDING BEFORE THE ZONING HEARING BOARD AND THE BOCA BOARD OF
APPEALS.

A flat fee of \$25.00 shall be charged by the Borough of Monroeville for accep-
tance of any application for any type of proceeding before the Zoning Hearing
Board and the Boca Board of Appeals.

SECTION 3. Section 8 of the aforesaid Ordinances shall be amended to
read as follows:

A minimum fee of \$100.00 for every 3,000 square feet of any building, or any
portion thereof, for the issuance of any occupancy certificate.

SECTION 4. The following Section 10 shall be added to the aforesaid
Ordinances:

Section 10. APPLICATIONS BEFORE THE BOROUGH PLANNING COMMISSION. Except
as otherwise herein provided, a flat fee of \$100.00 shall be charged by the
Borough of Monroeville for the acceptance of any application or any type
proceeding before the Borough Planning Commission.

NOTE:

The foregoing ordinance was not approved by the Mayor. Section 1007 of the Borough Code reads as follows:

"If any such ordinance or resolution shall not be returned by the Mayor at the regular meeting of the Council occurring at least ten days next succeeding its presentation to him, it shall likewise have as full force as if it had been approved...

"The enactment of an ordinance shall be the date when the Mayor shall approve it or the date of passage by the Council over the veto of the Mayor, or in the case of any ordinance not returned by the Mayor at the regular meeting of Council, occurring at least ten days after the meeting at which such ordinance was passed by the Council, the date of enactment shall be the date of such succeeding regular meeting of Council."
