

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONROEVILLE
ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF CHERRY HILL DRIVE

WHEREAS, a certain plan of streets and lots has heretofore been laid out and approved by the Borough of Monroeville, known as Cherry Hill Plan of Lots No. 5 as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in Plan Book Volume 89, Pages 179 and 180; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Monroeville has been requested to accept and adopt Cherry Hill Drive in the Cherry Hill Plan of Lots No. 5;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Monroeville in Council assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of Cherry Hill Drive, fifty (50) feet wide, as shown and laid out in the Cherry Hill Plan of Lots No. 5, recorded as aforesaid and containing a total length of five hundred eight (508) feet, more or less.

Section 2. The grades for the street accepted hereunder and hereby established as the existing grades, reserving however to the Borough of Monroeville the right to change such grades without liability to adjacent property or property owners thereof.

Section 3. The Council of the Borough of Monroeville, by separate resolution, shall more precisely locate the said street and establish the existing grades at the center line in accordance with the As-Built Plan of the same submitted to and approved by the Borough Engineer.

Section 4. The Borough of Monroeville hereby accepts for municipal purposes all the storm and sanitary sewers servicing the lots adjacent to the street hereinabove described and located within the said street right-of-way or adjacent lots, together with any easements or additional rights-of-way therefor as shown on the said plan, to be part of the storm water and sanitary sewer system of the Borough of Monroeville.
