

ORDINANCE NO. 1007

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE PROHIBITING SMOKING ON SCHOOL AND OTHER BUSES AND OTHER PUBLIC CONVEYANCES, REQUIRING THE POSTING OF SIGNS REGARDING THE SAID PROHIBITION AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Municipality of Monroeville to provide for the health, safety and general welfare of its residents, businesses and visitors.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of prohibiting smoking of any type on school buses and other buses and public conveyances of all types.

1. No person shall smoke any cigarette, cigar, tobacco, drug or any similar item on any school bus, other bus, other public conveyance, vehicle of public accommodations of any kind in the Municipality of Monroeville.
2. Every person, firm, entity, company, corporation, partnership, association or business of any nature owning or having management or control of any conveyance or vehicle mentioned or contemplated by Section 1, hereinabove set forth shall keep posted in prominent and conspicuous places in each of said buses, conveyances or vehicles a sufficient number of conspicuously lettered signs warning against violations of the "no smoking" provision required by this ordinance and calling to attention the penalty for such violation. A sufficient number shall mean that anyone of the signs shall be readable from any place in the bus, conveyance or vehicle large enough for a person to occupy.
3. Any person or persons violating any provision or provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding before a district magistrate or other proper authority be sentenced to pay a fine not to exceed \$300.00 and in default of said payment to be confined to the Allegheny County jail or other proper institution for a period of not less than one nor more than five days.
4. Any ordinance or part thereof conflicting with the terms of this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
