

ORDINANCE NO. 1058

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 36 AND PREVENTING SOLICI-
TING IN THE MUNICIPALITY BY NON-RESIDENTS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. The following Section 1a shall be added to Ordinance No. 36:

- a) Notwithstanding any other provisions herein it shall be unlawful for any non-resident or business of any nature not having a place of business in Monroeville to engage in any soliciting, peddling, selling or hawking of any goods or merchandise of any nature from house to house or on the public streets, alleys, roads or highways.

Section 2. Section 7 shall be amended to read as follows:

That every person or persons, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance or failing to secure such a license as aforesaid, shall upon conviction, in summary proceedings before the appropriate District Magistrate of the Municipality of Monroeville, pay a fine not less than \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00 together with costs, for each offense or violation and in default of payment of fine and costs, shall be committed to the Allegheny County Jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.
