

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF CEDAR RIDGE DRIVE

WHEREAS, a certain street has heretofore been laid out and approved by the Municipality of Monroeville in Resolution No. 68-24 and Section 4 requiring that the road be dedicated to the Municipality of Monroeville, and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville has been requested to accept and adopt Cedar Ridge Drive.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. The Municipality of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of Cedar Ridge Drive, fifty (50) feet wide, containing a total length of twelve-hundred seventy-six feet (1276').

Section 2. The grades for the streets accepted hereunder and hereby established as the existing grades, reserving however to the Municipality of Monroeville the right to change such grades without liability to adjacent property or property owners thereof.

Section 3. The Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, by separate resolution, shall more precisely locate the said street and establish the existing grades at the center line in accordance with the As-Built Plan of the same submitted to and approved by the Municipal Engineer.

Section 4. The Municipality of Monroeville hereby accepts for municipal purposes all the storm and sanitary sewers servicing the above street.
