

ORDINANCE NO. 1097

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
PROHIBITING THE USE, POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION OF
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT PUBLICLY OWNED FACILITIES
IN MONROEVILLE

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville and Gateway School District have experienced various problems with the use of alcoholic beverages at public functions using publicly owned facilities.

WHEREAS, Gateway School District has passed a resolution prohibiting the use or possession of alcoholic beverages on school grounds.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled, as follows:

- 1) No person shall be permitted to use, possess or consume any type of alcoholic beverage within or on a publicly owned facility in Monroeville, unless such person shall have obtained a permit to authorize the use of any such publicly owned facility for such purpose.
- 2) Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to pay a penalty not to exceed \$300.00 per violation.
- 3) Any ordinance or part thereof in conflict with any word, sentence, paragraph or phrase hereof is hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.
