

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 848 REGULATING TRAFFIC,
PARKING, AND IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same that Article III, Section 4 is amended to add the following:

However, the Municipal Council may, after public notice and report from the Police Department, exempt certain streets or highways from the limitations of this section upon determination that literal enforcement hereof would result in a severe and unnecessary hardship to adjacent property owners or occupiers. Council shall be guided in its determination of severe and unnecessary hardship by the following criterion:

- (1) Older developed areas where residences exist without driveways, off street parking areas, garages, or other designated space for vehicular parking.

Temporary exemption may be granted by the Municipal Manager and Chief of Police after investigation for no longer than one month in duration to cover such contingencies as driveway construction and renovation, temporary house guests, and other unusual circumstances.
