

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
VACATING A 20 FOOT UNNAMED ALLEY LYING BETWEEN
FIRST AVENUE AND SECOND AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. That a portion of an unnamed alley 20 feet wide lying between First Avenue and Second Avenue in the Mellon's Plan of Routh Place be and the same is hereby vacated as follows:

ALL that certain lot or parcel of ground specifically described as follows:

A twenty foot (20') unnamed alley lying between First Avenue and Second Avenue and running from Vista Street to the Mellon's Kenny Farm Place Plan, a distance of 1042 feet, more or less, bounded on the North by lots 38 through 72 inclusive and on the south by lots 6 through 37 inclusive and being part of the Mellon's Plan of Routh Place as recorded in Plan Book Volume 22, pages 144-5 in the Recorder's Office of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.

Section 2. The ownership of the ground hereby vacated shall revert to the adjacent property owners in accordance with law.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the provisions of the Monroeville Home Rule Charter, Section IV.

Section 4. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.
