

ORDINANCE NO. 1248

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE  
DEFINING, ESTABLISHING A LICENSE FEE AND LICENSE  
REQUIREMENT FOR TRADE SHOWS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. LICENSE REQUIRED.

No person shall conduct a trade show within the Municipality of Monroeville without first obtaining a license from the License Officer designated by the Monroeville Municipal Manager.

Section 2. DEFINITION.

"Trade show" means any exhibition, sale or display, at which goods, merchandise or services are sold and in which at least ten persons participate who deal in the type of goods, merchandise or service exhibited, sold or displayed.

Section 3. QUALIFICATIONS.

The applicant shall either be a Monroeville resident who deals in the goods, merchandise or services to be exhibited, or the owner or lessee of the premises upon which the trade fair is to be held.

Section 4. APPLICATION.

Application shall be filed at least two weeks prior to the opening of the trade show. The application shall state the names, addresses and businesses of all persons who are to participate in the trade show, the site and any other pertinent information requested by the License Officer.

Section 5. LICENSE FEE.

The fee for a trade show license shall be Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.

Section 6. FINE.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof before the Mayor or any Justices of the Peace of the Municipality of Monroeville, pay a fine in an amount not exceeding Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, together with costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of the fine and costs, shall be subject to imprisonment in the Allegheny County Jail or Workhouse for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation of this Ordinance continues to exist shall be considered a separate offense, and may be punishable as such.

Section 7. REPEALER.

Any ordinance or part of an ordinance is in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance it is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
