

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
VACATING A PORTION OF OLD WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY
IN THE VICINITY OF AERO TRUCKING COMPANY

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. That a portion of Old William Penn Highway in the vicinity of Aero Trucking is hereby vacated as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the right-of-way line of present L.R. 186 Travel Route U.S. 22 at the right-of-way line at Station 493+80 as shown on plans by the Pennsylvania Department of Highways dated November 14, 1940; thence along the center line of the road N 62° 18" 40' East a distance of 248.665'; thence by a curb to the right with a radius of 438.10' a distance of 81.04' to the West right-of-way line of McClure Road; said point being 44' on a radius of 438.10' from the center line of the paved portion of McClure Road and Old William Penn Highway; that point being N 10° 33" 20' East 190' from the right-of-way line of present U.S. Route 22. The right-of-way herein vacated is 50' wide for its entire length.

Section 2. The ownership of the ground hereby vacated shall revert to the property owners in accordance with law.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the provisions of the Monroeville Home Rule Charter, Section IV.

Section 4. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.
