

ORDINANCE NO. 1266

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE  
AMENDING AND REVOKING ORDINANCE NO. 1248, DEFINING  
TRADE SHOWS, ESTABLISHING A LICENSE FEE AND LICENSE  
REQUIREMENT FOR TRADE SHOWS

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council  
assembled as follows:

Section 1. LICENSE REQUIRED.

No person shall conduct a trade show within the Municipality of Monroeville  
without first obtaining a license from the License Officer designated by  
the Monroeville Municipal Manager.

Section 2. DEFINITION.

"Trade Show" means any exhibition, sale or display, where goods, merchandise  
or services are sold and having at least ten persons participate who deal  
in the type of goods, merchandise or service exhibited, sold or traded.

Section 3. QUALIFICATIONS.

The "applicant" shall either be the owner or lessee of the premises upon  
which the trade show is being held.

Section 4. APPLICATION.

An application shall be filed prior to the opening of the trade show. The  
application shall state the names, addresses and businesses of all persons  
who are to participate in the trade show, the site and any other pertinent  
information requested by the License Officer.

Section 5. LICENSE FEE

License fee shall be \$1.00 per booth, exhibit or display or \$1.00 per 100  
square feet of booth, exhibit or display space, whichever is greater. Pay  
shall be made at the time of the license application or may be made on a  
quarterly basis by the owner or lessee of the premises upon which trade show  
is being conducted.

Section 6. FINE.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance  
shall, upon summary conviction thereof before any magistrate having jurisdic-  
tion, pay a fine in an amount not exceeding the sum of Five Hundred  
(\$500.00) Dollars, together with costs of prosecution.
