

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 611 and 717 PROVIDING FOR
THE COLLECTION AND ROMOVAL OF GARBAGE FROM CERTAIN
RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES AND PROVIDING FOR CURB-SIDE
GARBAGE PICKUP FOR SINGLE FAMILY ATTACHED DWELLINGS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 611 shall read as follows:

Such garbage cans as mentioned above whether to be collected by the Municipality or a contractor for the Municipality shall be placed and located outdoors within one hundred ten (110) feet of the nearest street curb-line or within ten (10) feet of a dwelling house with respect to persons occupying one (1) and two (2) family dwellings except that garbage, rubbish or refuse of persons occupying single family attached dwellings shall be placed at the street curb-line provided that the owners of the streets, parking areas, or common owned areas grant to the Municipality the right and authority to enter on to the private property for the purpose of curb-side garbage pick-up and release and hold harmless the Municipality from any damage or loss (except as may be caused by the negligence of the Municipality).

Section 2. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 611 "Charges for Collection" and Section 1 Ordinance No. 717 "Charges for Collection" is hereby deleted.

Section 3. Repealer.

Any Ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
