

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REAPPORTIONING
THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE AND CHANGING THE
PRESENT BOUNDARY LINES OF THE WARDS WITHIN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania provides that each municipality having a governing body not entirely elected at large shall reapportion by its governing body into election districts composed of compact and contiguous territory as nearly equal in population as practicable, for the purpose of describing the districts for those not elected at large; and

WHEREAS, the United States Census Bureau has released its official census for the year 1980, which census fixes the population of the Municipality of Monroeville at 30,977; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville has heretofore been divided into seven wards with a population as follows:

WARD

No. 1	5,291
No. 2	4,167
No. 3	4,184
No. 4	4,736
No. 5	4,670
No. 6	4,314
No. 7	3,615; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the decisions of the United States Supreme Court, the Municipality of Monroeville has formed a Reapportionment Committee which Committee reviewed the applicable census figures and submitted a plan dividing the Municipality of Monroeville into seven wards, maintaining ward boundaries with a minimal amount of change; and

WHEREAS, the division of the population in the seven wards would be as follows:

WARD

No. 1	4,434
No. 2	4,426
No. 3	4,433
No. 4	4,417
No. 5	4,415
No. 6	4,422
No. 7	4,430

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. That the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville hereby reapportions the Municipality of Monroeville into seven wards, such division as shown on the plan attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and made part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That the present Councilpersons serving for the previously existing seven wards shall remain in office, and shall hold such office for the term for which each was elected.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not affect the present wards or election districts therein until the primary elections of 1982.

Section 4. That a copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Director of the County Board of Elections.
