

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY TO UTILIZE ELECTRIC
OR OTHER TYPES OF SPEED TIMING DEVICES TO MEASURE
THE RATE OF SPEED OF VEHICLES WHEN SUCH DEVICES
ARE IN USE

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. The Municipality of Monroeville through its Police Department or other authorized agency or representative is hereby authorized to use electric, mechanical or other speed timing devices not otherwise prohibited by law, to measure the rate of speed of vehicles where authorized to do so in accordance with local law and/or the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (75 PS Sub-section 101 et. seq.)

Section 2. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such a conflict.
