

ORDINANCE NO. 1330

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE
MUNICIPALITY TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
BOROUGH OF TURTLE CREEK FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND
MAINTENANCE OF A SANITARY SEWER LINE NEAR THE
TURTLE CREEK/MONROEVILLE BORDER AND LYNN AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council
assembled as follows:

Section 1. The Municipality of Monroeville is hereby authorized to enter
an Agreement with the Borough of Turtle Creek for the construction and maintenance
of a sanitary sewer line near the Turtle Creek/Monroeville border and Lynn Avenue.

Section 2. A copy of said Agreement is attached hereto, made a part hereof
and marked Exhibit "A".

EXHIBIT "A"
A G R E E M E N T

THIS Agreement, made this 11th day of May, 1982, by and between the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, a Municipal Corporation having its principal place of business at 2700 Monroeville Boulevard, Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Monroeville"

TURTLE CREEK BOROUGH, a Municipal Corporation, having its principal place of business at 125 Monroeville Avenue, Turtle Creek, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Turtle Creek".

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, there is need to be constructed a sanitary sewer line near the southerly border of Monroeville and the border of Turtle Creek, and

WHEREAS, funding is available to construct said sanitary sewer line through the Turtle Creek Council of Governments, a non-profit corporation, funded by the County of Allegheny, and

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer line to be constructed lies within the territorial boundaries of Monroeville and will discharge into the main sanitary sewer line in the Borough of Turtle Creek, and

WHEREAS, the Parties are desirous of entering this Agreement in accordance with the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement Act. (Act No. 180 of July 12, 1972, 53 P.S. Sec 481 et. seq)

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above and intending to be legally bound hereby the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The parties hereto will allow to be constructed a sanitary sewer line by the Turtle Creek Council of Governments and paid for by the Turtle Creek Council of Governments pursuant to a grant of money from the County of Allegheny.

2. The said sanitary sewer line shall be constructed along the easterly line of Lynn Avenue in Monroeville from 1616 Lynn Avenue South to its intersection with Rebecca Street and the line shall continue through the territorial boundaries of Turtle Creek to a main sanitary sewer line and shall consist of approximately 700 lineal feet within Monroeville.

3. The number of tap-ins for the sanitary sewer line referenced herein and to be constructed shall be one per dwelling and not to exceed fifteen sanitary sewer tap-ins.

4. Sewer charges shall be assessed by the respective community in which a property is situate.

5. Cost of maintenance of the sanitary sewer line herein referenced and to be constructed shall be pro-rated in accordance with the respective number of homes tapped into the said sanitary sewer line as may be located in Monroeville and Turtle Creek respectively.

6. Any part of the said sanitary sewer line within the boundaries of either Municipality (Monroeville or Turtle Creek) shall be owned by that respective Municipality

7. No other tap-in of any other dwelling or building shall be permitted on said sanitary sewer line unless otherwise agreed by the Parties hereto.

8. This Agreement represents the entire understanding between the Parties, there are no other covenants, conditions or representations that are not specifically herein set forth and any amendment hereto shall be in writing and executed by all of the Parties hereto.
