

ORDINANCE NO. 1332

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE
MUNICIPALITY TO ENTER A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH
MONROEVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY #5 FOR THE
LEASE OF A FORD VAN AMBULANCE TO MONROEVILLE
VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY #5

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council
assembled as follows:

Section 1. The Municipality of Monroeville is authorized to enter a lease
agreement with Monroeville Volunteer Fire Company #5 for the lease of a Ford
van ambulance to Monroeville Fire Company #5.

Section 2. A copy of said lease agreement is attached hereto, made a part
hereof and marked Exhibit "A".

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 19th day of January, 1982, by and between the MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, a governmental unit existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and maintaining its principal place of business at 2700 Monroeville Boulevard, Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, Party of the First Part, hereinafter referred to as "Municipality",

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MONROEVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY #5, a non-profit organization which maintains its principal place of business on Seco Road in the Municipality of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, Party of the Second Part, hereinafter referred to as "Fire Company #5".

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, Municipality holds title to a certain Ford van ambulance and desires to lease same to Fire Company #5; and

WHEREAS, Fire Company #5 is desirous of leasing said Ford van ambulance from Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable and sufficient consideration the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, as well as the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Municipality agrees to lease to Fire Company #5 all that certain vehicle or personal property known and identified as a 1982 Ford van ambulance bearing Title No. 34174641 and Vehicle No. VIN-1FTJS34L9CHA10777 for the sole and exclusive use of Fire Company #5 in connection with the performance of its activities as a volunteer fire company.

2. Municipality confirms and agrees that delivery of said 1982 Ford van ambulance was made to Fire Company #5 on January 19, 1982.

3. Fire Company #5 agrees to lease from Municipality the said 1982 Ford van ambulance and acknowledges the delivery of said vehicle to its custody and control on January 19, 1982.

4. Fire Company #5 does further agree to be solely responsible for the care, maintenance and operation of said vehicle and to provide all necessary and appropriate insurance pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania including but not limited to third party liability and the loss, damage or destruction of the vehicle.

5. Fire Company #5 does further agree to utilize said vehicle in connection with its official duties and responsibilities as a volunteer fire company only.

6. The parties hereto agree that this lease shall be for a period of three (3) years from the date hereof. At the expiration of the said three (3) year period, Municipality does hereby agree to transfer, assign and set over to Fire Company #5 all of its right, title and interest in and to the said 1982 Ford van ambulance.

7. No alteration, modification, or amendment to this Agreement shall be enforceable in Law or in Equity unless in writing and signed by both of the parties hereto.

HAVING READ the foregoing and intending to be legally bound hereby, for themselves, their successors and assigns, the parties hereto pursuant to proper authority, have caused their authorized officers to execute this Agreement.
