AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
ESTABLISHING A CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON
MUNICIPAL REVENUE RESTRUCTURING AND STATING THE
PURPOSES, DURATION, COMPOSITION, AND ADMINISTRA-
TIVE SUPPORT FOR SUCH COMMITTEE

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. Purpose

The Citizens' Advisory Committee on Municipal Revenue Restructuring is created for the purpose of reviewing and recommending to Council an alternate revenue resource plan to replace the revenue lost as a result of the 1982 Mercantile Tax decision rendered by the Court of Common Pleas. The committee may also provide information on the general nature and extent of the problem to Council along with other data which may be helpful in the understanding of the Municipal revenue situation in Monroeville.

Section 2. Duration

The Citizens' Advisory Committee on Municipal Revenue Restructuring shall terminate upon fulfillment of its designated purposes or on November 30, 1982 whichever comes first. A reasonable extension of time may be granted by majority vote of Council, but each extension must be for a specific time interval.

Section 3. Composition and Qualifications

The Citizens' Advisory committee on Municipal Revenue Restructuring shall be composed of five members. Committee members shall be appointed by Municipal Council as prescribed by the Monroeville Home Rule Charter.

A representative from the following organizations or interests is deemed desirable for committee service although not mandatory:

- 1) Monroeville Area Chamber of Commerce;
- 2) Municipal Depository;
- 3) Senior Citizens;
- 4) Neighborhood and/or Civic Associations; and
- 5) Real Estate developers or realtors

At least one member of Council shall serve as an ex-officio member of the committee for the purpose of liaison as shall the Municipal Manager.

Section 4. Administrative Support

Administrative support shall be provided by assigning such staff members and clerical personnel from the career service as may be deemed appropriate by the Municipal Manager after joint discussion with the committee. A reasonable estimate of any contemplated expenses, e.g. printing of report, shall be presented for Council approval as soon as possible and when needed by the Committee.

A majority of those present and voting shall prevail on issues requiring decisions by the Committee. However, any member voting in the minority shall have the opportunity of filing with the Minutes of the meeting at which the vote was taken, a minority opinion and position which shall be attached to said minutes.
