

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
PROVIDING FOR CONTINUATION OF HOSPITALIZATION FOR
RETIREES WITH TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS OF SERVICE
OR MORE UNTIL ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDICAID/MEDICARE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council assembled as follows:

ARTICLE I - APPLICABILITY

This ordinance shall apply to all employees not covered by an existing or pending collective bargaining agreement pursuant to Act 111 or Act 195 who retire after the effective date of this ordinance.

ARTICLE II - CONDITIONS FOR ELIGIBILITY

The employee must have completed twenty-five (25) years or more service at the date of retirement with the Municipality of Monroeville.

Employment with another employer or self employment is prohibited.

Hospitalization provision ceases at death, age 65, or when the retiree first becomes eligible for Medicaid/Medicare, or otherwise qualifies for a hospitalization benefit from any other source.

ARTICLE III - COVERAGES

Coverage is for the same persons as the day before eligibility. No additional persons can be added to the coverage.

ARTICLE IV - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the Home Rule Charter provisions.
