

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF WYNGATE DRIVE

WHEREAS, a certain plan of streets and lots has heretofore been laid out and approved by the Municipality of Monroeville, known as The United States Steel Plan No. 2 of Lots as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Allegheny county, Pennsylvania in Plan Book Volume 124, pages 93 to 95; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville has been requested to accept and adopt Wyngate Drive in The United States Steel Plan No. 2 of Lots; and

WHEREAS, the above roads have been finished and completed in accordance with the regulations and ordinances of the Municipality of Monroeville, and maintenance bond in the amount of \$10,000 for two years is to be filed,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. The Municipality of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of Wyngate Drive, sixty (60) feet wide, as shown and laid out in The United States Steel Plan No. 2 of Lots, recorded as aforesaid and containing a total length of nine hundred and seventeen (917) feet for Wyngate Drive.

Section 2. The grades for the streets accepted hereunder and hereby established as the existing grades, reserving however to the Municipality of Monroeville the right to change such grades without liability to adjacent property or property owners thereof.

Section 3. The Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, by separate resolution, shall more precisely locate the said streets and establish the existing grades at the center line in accordance with the As-Built Plan of the same submitted to and approved by the Municipal Engineer.

Section 4. The Municipality of Monroeville hereby accepts for municipal purposes all the storm and sanitary sewers servicing the lots adjacent to the streets hereinabove described and located within the said streets right-of-way or adjacent lots, together with any easement or additional rights-of-way therefor as shown on the said Plan, to be part of the storm water and sanitary sewer system of the Municipality of Monroeville.
