

ORDINANCE NO. 1406

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MONROEVILLE
ARTS COUNCIL INCORPORATED FOR THE PURPOSE OF
PROMOTING AND STIMULATING PARTICIPATION IN AND
APPRECIATION OF THE ARTS AND THE PROMOTION OF
THE CULTURAL GROWTH OF THE COMMUNITY

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville in Council
assembled as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and Municipal Manager of the Municipality of
Monroeville are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Monroeville
Arts Council Incorporated, for the purpose of promoting and stimulating
participation in and appreciation of the arts and the promotion of the cultural
growth of the community.

Section 2. The agreement is hereby approved and ratified and a copy of said
agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".

EXHIBIT "A"

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 14th day of February, 1984, by and between MONROEVILLE ARTS COUNCIL, INCORPORATED, a non-profit corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and situate in the Municipality of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Arts Council",

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THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, a Municipal Corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and having its principal place of business at 2700 Monroeville Boulevard, Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Municipality".

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the Arts Council has been created and incorporated to promote and stimulate participation in and appreciation of the arts, to coordinate the programming activities of its various members and to promote the cultural growth of the community, and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has provided in its 1984 Municipal Budget for a \$5,000.00 contribution to the Arts Council for the beginning of an expanded Community Cultural Arts Program within the Municipality, this contribution being in addition to a grant received from the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts after its review of the project application submitted by the Municipality in conjunction with the Arts Council, and

WHEREAS, the Municipality in cooperation with the Monroeville Arts Council has applied for and received from the Pennsylvania Council for the Arts a grant in the amount of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars to promote and conduct cultural and artistic programs, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Parties hereto to enter into an agreement for the provision of a Community Cultural Arts Program for the year 1984.

NOW THEREFORE, In consideration of the mutual promises and agreements herein contained, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. PARTICIPATION - The Arts Council agrees that all activities and events through the community Cultural Arts Program shall be open to all Monroeville residents and that any fees, charges or assessments shall receive approval by the Municipality prior to being levied.
2. BUDGET - The Arts Council shall develop and then submit to the Municipal Council a budget setting forth dollar projections and a narrative description of the activities and events which shall be provided through the Community Cultural Arts Program.
3. BOOKS AND RECORDS - The Arts Council shall maintain proper books and records for auditing purposes of all expenditures of Municipal and State funds and make the same available to the Municipality upon request.

4. PUBLICITY - The Arts Council agrees that the Municipality, the Mayor, Municipal Council and the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts shall be appropriately referenced in the publicity used and distributed relative to the presentation of activities and events which shall be provided through the Community Cultural Arts Program.

5. COORDINATOR OF PROGRAM - The Arts Council shall coordinate with the Director of Recreation and Human Services of the Municipality, or any other additional person designated by the appropriate officials of the Municipality, all matters relative to the presentation of the activities and events which shall be provided through the Community Cultural Arts Program.

6. MINUTES - The Arts Council shall provide on a timely basis to each the Mayor, Council persons of the Municipality, Municipal Manager and the Director of Human Services, a copy of the minutes and/or other reports or mechanisms used by the Council to detail the operation and progress of the activities and events which shall be provided through the Community Cultural Arts Program.

7. FINANCIAL REPORT - The Arts Council shall provide a financial report to the Municipality within three (3) months of the completion of the activities and events provided through the Community Cultural Arts Program.

8. INSURANCE - Events sponsored through the Community Cultural Arts Program shall be covered by the Municipality's policy of general public liability insurance against claims for personal injury of property damage, with limits at least \$1,000,000 for bodily injury and \$500,000 for property damage.

9. PROGRAMMING - The Arts Council agrees that the type or kinds of programming to be presented through the Community Cultural Arts Program shall be those that are, or are similar to those described by the Parties in their joint Pennsylvania Council on the Arts project application (a community arts festival, a recital, a concert series, support of the community orchestra, etc.)

10. COMPLIANCE WITH GRANT - The Arts Council acknowledges the grant of public monies from the Municipality of Monroeville and the Pennsylvania Council for the Arts and agrees to comply with all terms and conditions of the grant received.
