AND NOW, on May 13, 1986, it is ORDAINED

AND ENACTED, by Municipal Council of the Municipality of Monroeville as follows:

Section 1: In accordance with the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S.A. Section 7101, et seq., at Section 7501 (b), a declaration of a disaster emergency shall be made by the Mayor or in his absence, the Deputy Mayor, or in his absence, the Municipal Manager which declaration of a disaster emergency shall be subject to ratification by Municipal Council.

Section 2: In accordance with the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Service Code, 35 Pa. C.S.A. Section 7101, et. seq., at Section 7502 (a) and (c), the coordinator of the Monroeville Emergency Management Agency shall be subject to the direction and control of the Mayor or in his absence, the Deputy Mayor, or in his absnce, the Municipal Manager. Municipal Council hereby recommends to the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Public Safety Director, for appointment as the Monroeville Emergency Management Agency Coordinator and the Fire Official, for appointment as the Deputy Emergency Management Agency Coordinator.

Section 3: In accordance with the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S.A. Section 7101, et. seq., a committee shall be established consisting of (a) representatives from the Monroeville Volunteer Fire and Ambulance Personnel, which representatives shall be designated by the Monroeville volunteer fire and ambulance personnel (b) representatives from Monroeville Municipal Council to be designated by the Deputy Mayor (c) the fire official (d) the public safety director (e) the police chief and (f) the Municipal Manager.

Said committee shall review and if necessary, rewrite and further clarify the Monroeville Emergency Management Plan and define relationships between the Municipality and volunteer fire and ambulance personnel.

Section 4: Any ordinance, resolution or regulations or part thereof which is inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.
