

MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 1547

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY OF THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE ACTING MUNICIPAL MANAGER AND THE MUNICIPAL ATTORNEY; AND GRANTING THE ACTING MUNICIPAL MANAGER, MS. CAROL YOUNG, AND THE MUNICIPAL ATTORNEY, ROBERT N. HACKETT, THE RIGHT TO ENGAGE IN NON-MUNICIPAL EMPLOYMENT.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville (hereinafter "MONROEVILLE") has appointed Carol T. Young as Acting Manager of Monroeville to exercise the powers and perform the duties of the office of manager for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, pursuant to Section 706 of the Monroeville Home Rule, Charter; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 501(i) and 701 of the Monroeville Home Rule Charter, it is necessary to fix the compensation of Carol T. Young as the said Acting Manager; and

WHEREAS, Carol T. Young, Acting Manager of Monroeville, has appointed Robert N. Hackett, Esquire, as Municipal Attorney with the advice and consent of the Municipal Council pursuant to Section 801(a) of the Monroeville Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 501(i) of the Monroeville Home Rule Charter it is necessary to fix the compensation of Robert N. Hackett, Esquire, as such Municipal Attorney; and

WHEREAS, Carol T. Young and Robert N. Hackett, Esquire, have disclosed non-municipal employment, which requires approval pursuant to Section 1506(b) of the Monroeville Home Rule Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That Monroeville shall compensate Carol T. Young as Acting Manager of Monroeville, at the flat rate of Fifty-Five Dollars (\$55.00) per hour, payable bi-weekly, and shall also compensate Carol T. Young for documented expenses

incurred in the performance of her duties, including, but not limited to, travel expenses and telephone charges. Any paraprofessional services rendered shall be compensated at the rate of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) per hour.

Section 2. That Monroeville shall compensate Robert N. Hackett, Esquire, as Municipal Attorney, for legal services performed at the rate of Ninety Dollars (\$90.00) per hour. Robert N. Hackett, Esquire, will be assisted in the performance of his duties as (Acting) Municipal Attorney by other professional personnel in his law firm. The charges for legal and paralegal services rendered by such persons shall be compensated by Monroeville as follows: legal services performed by Joan P. Feldman, Esquire, shall be paid at the rate of Ninety Dollars (\$90.00) per hour; legal services performed by law clerks and paralegal personnel shall be paid at the rate of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) per hour. Robert N. Hackett, Esquire and the aforesaid law firm personnel shall also be compensated for documented expenses incurred in the performance of their duties including, but not limited to, expenses for document reproduction, telephone, postage and delivery services. Bills shall be paid monthly.

Section 3. That Monroeville has been advised of and consents to Carol T. Young's non-municipal employment as President of OPUS, INC. and as a Partner of Municipal Consulting Associates.

Section 4. That Monroeville has been advised that Robert N. Hackett, Esquire is engaged in the general practice of law and that he is associated in that practice with other attorney and paraprofessional personnel who will assist him in the performance of his duties as Municipal Attorney. Monroeville consents to Mr. Hackett's non-municipal employment and to his and the law firm's continuation in the general practice of law including, but not limited to, Robert N. Hackett's position as Township Attorney for the Township of Upper St. Clair and counsel to Municipal Consulting Associates.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. If any parts of this Ordinance are declared illegal or unlawful the remaining parts shall survive and remain in full force and effect.
