AND NOW, on this 9 day of June, 1987, it is
ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Municipal Council of the Municipality of
Monroeville as follows:

SECTION 1: The Planning and Construction Code, Ordinance
No. 1527, at Chapter 204 entitled "Sidewalk Regulations" is hereby
amended as follows:

Paragraph 5.100, subparagraph 2, is hereby amended
to read as follows:

All Other - Sidewalks shall be placed on
grade at a uniform distance from the curb as
recommended by the Planning Commission and
approved by Municipal Council. The intent
is to have a uniform aesthetic pleasing
expanse of sidewalk parallel to the curb.

SECTION 2: These pages of this Ordinance shall be
inserted as an addendum to the Planning and Construction Code
and the amendment set forth in Section 1 shall be inserted as
noted in Section 204 of the Planning and Construction Code.

SECTION 3: Any ordinance, or part of an ordinance, in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
