ORDINANCE NO. 1604

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE CONDEMNATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNED BY HENRY HARTMAN, JOSEPH C. AND THERESA F. KIREN, HAROLD P. COYLE, AND CONSTANCE BATLEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE INSTALLATION OF A SANITARY SEWER KNOWN AS THE "SMITH LANE SANITARY SEWER" IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the Borough Code, Section 1501, 53 P.S. §46501, authorizes the Municipality of Monroeville to appropriate private property for the purpose of constructing and reconstructing sanitary sewers and to declare such appropriation as a taking of private property for public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: That the proper Municipal Officials are hereby authorized to execute and file a Declaration of Taking pursuant to the Borough Code 53 P.S. §46501 for the purpose of appropriating a 15' sanitary sewer easement on and across

properties owned by Henry Hartman, Joseph C. and Theresa F. Kiren, Harold P. Coyle and Constance Batley as reputed owners, or whomsoever may be the owners, and located in or near the Coyle Plan of lots in Monroeville, Pennsylvania, and more particularly described in the accompanying legal descriptions. Copies of said descriptions are attached hereto and collectively marked as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: That the Municipality may assess the cost and expenses thereof, in whole or in part, upon land or properties particularly benefitted, if appropriate, pursuant to 53 P.S. 47001.

SECTION 3: That any Ordinance, or part thereof, that may conflict herewith, be and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
