ORDINANCE NO. 1625

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE PROPER OFFICIALS OF MONROEVILLE TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDMENT TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE MONROEVILLE POLICE OFFICERS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1598.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. The proper officials of the Municipality of Monroeville are hereby authorized to enter into an amendment to the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Monroeville Police Department, effective immediately, concerning the subjects of overtime and hospitalization insurance.

SECTION 2. A copy of said amendment to the Collective Bargaining Agreement is attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".


SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 1598 is hereby amended to include the terms set forth in Exhibit "A" concerning overtime and hospitalization insurance.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

The current practice with regards to compensation for hearings, pre-trial and court appearances on days off shall be amended as follows:

Hearings - In lieu of compensation at one and a half the regular rate, the officer will receive compensatory time of two (2) hours.

Pre-trial- In lieu of compensation at one and a half the regular rate, the officer will receive compensatory time of four (4) hours.

Court Time (on Day Off) - In lieu of being paid time and a half for court appearance on an officer's day off, the officer will receive compensatory time off at time and a half, at the officers discretion, with the exception of holidays and/or Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. All full day compensatory time must be taken within a thirty (30) day period. Compensatory time for hearings, pre-trials, and half days can be accumulated to a full eight (8) hours. Any partial days accumulated until a full eight (8) hour day is obtained must be taken within a thirty (30) day period.

The following benefits will be derived by all officers that were members of the bargaining unit at the inception of the 1988-1989 Bargaining Agreement as a result of these policy changes:

1. All hospitalization coverage will be extended to the spouse of a retiring officer, until the spouse reaches Medicare eligibility.
2. Spouses of retiring officers will also receive 65 Special upon reaching Medicare eligibility.

Police Bargaining Unit Representatives acknowledge that the Police Bargaining Unit Membership has accepted by 99% approval, the above contract provision changes per the 1988-89 Police Collective Bargaining Agreement.
