ORDINANCE NO. 1636

SECTION 1. The Municipality of Monroeville hereby accepts the dedication of Trotwood Court, in the Trotwood East Plan of Lots No. 2; a total distance of approximately 0.004 miles, as more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

## HORIZONTAL CENTERLINE DESCRIPTION

Trotwood Court - 50' Wide  
Trotwood East Plan No. 2  
Municipality of Monroeville

Beginning at a point on the centerline of Haymaker Road (variable right-of-way) at Station 66 + 06.31 said point being N 85° 44' 00" E 27.50 feet from an existing monument in the westerly side of Haymaker Road; thence along the centerline of Haymaker Road N 04° 16' 00" W, 177.785 feet to the true point of beginning of this description; thence from true point of beginning and along the centerline of Trotwood Court (a 50 foot street) as recorded in the Trotwood East Plan No. 2, Recorder of Deeds Office, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania in Plan Book Volume 141 Pages 141 and 142, N 85° 44' 00" E, 205.00 feet to the centerpoint of a cul-de-sac having a radius of 50.00 feet, the end of this description.
