ORDINANCE NO. 1665

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF TRUCKS OR OTHER VEHICLES ON THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE UNLESS SUCH VEHICLES ARE LOADED IN SUCH A WAY TO PREVENT ANY OF ITS LOAD FROM SIFTING, LEAKING, OR ESCAPING ONTO THE ROADWAYS; AND FURTHER REQUIRING THAT TIGHTLY FITTING COVERS BE USED SO THAT THE LOAD OF ANY SUCH VEHICLE DOES NOT SIFT, LEAK OR ESCAPE ONTO THE ROADWAYS OF THE MUNICIPALITY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person who drops, or permits to be dropped or thrown, upon any street, highway or other public place in the Municipality of Monroeville, without the consent of the owner thereof, from a truck or other vehicle, any waste paper, sweepings, ashes, household waste, glass, metal, refuse or rubbish, or any dangerous or detrimental substance shall immediately remove the same or cause it to be removed.

SECTION 2. Any truck or other vehicle shall not be driven or moved on any street, highway or other public place in the Municipality of Monroeville unless such vehicle is so constructed, loaded or covered with a tightly fitting cover so as to prevent any waste paper, sweepings, ashes, household waste, glass, metal, refuse or rubbish, or any dangerous or detrimental substance from dropping, sifting, leaking or otherwise escaping therefrom onto the streets, highways or other public places of the Municipality; except that sand or other substances may be dropped for the purpose of securing traction, or water or other substances may be sprinkled on a roadway in cleaning or maintaining such roadway.

SECTION 3. No person shall operate any truck or other vehicle so as to track mud on any street, highway or other public place in the Municipality of Monroeville.

SECTION 4. For the purposes of this Ordinance, a person who permits to be dropped or thrown from a vehicle any of the items described in this Ordinance shall include the driver of the vehicle and the registrant of any vehicle registered in this Commonwealth from which any of the items are dropped or thrown, either by the registrant or any person operating, in possession of or present within the vehicle with the permission of the registrant, regardless of the registrant's intent or lack of knowledge with respect to the disposal, such items in violation of this Section where the registrant of the vehicle does not, with reasonable certainty, identify the driver of the vehicle at the time of the violation occurred.

SECTION 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of a summary of offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS.

SECTION 6. Any Ordinance or Resolution or part of an Ordinance or Resolution in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
