ORDINANCE NO. 1676

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, INCREASING THE BUDGET OF THE CONVENTION VISITORS BUREAU OF GREATER MONROEVILLE IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$75,000.00) DOLLARS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) BUSES, ONE FOR TWENTY-NINE (29) PASSENGERS AND ONE FOR SEVENTEEN (17) PASSENGERS, IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-THREE THOUSAND (\$63,000.00) DOLLARS; RELOCATION EXPENSES IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000.00) DOLLARS AND; RENT EXPENSES IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000.00) DOLLARS.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville to increase the budget of the Convention Visitors Bureau of Greater Monroeville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1 . The budget of the Convention Visitors Bureau is hereby amended to increase the budget in the amount of SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$75,000.00) DOLLARS for the following purposes:

- A.) Line Item 307 - Motorized Mobile Equipment: The purchase of two (2) buses, one for twenty-nine (29) passengers and one for seventeen (17) passengers, at a cost of SIXTY-THREE THOUSAND (\$63,000.00) DOLLARS;
- B.) Line Item 702 - Rent Buildings and Other Structures: Rent expenses the amount of TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000.00) DOLLARS; and
- C.) Line Item 308 - Office Furniture & Equipment: Relocation expenses in the amount of TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000.00) DOLLARS.

SECTION 2 . Title to the buses mentioned in Section 1 above shall be in the Municipality of Monroeville and the Municipality of Monroeville agrees to insure, service, maintain, operate, and identify the buses as a service of the Convention Visitors Bureau of Greater Monroeville

SECTION 3 . The buses mentioned in Section 1 and Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be jointly used by the Convention Visitors Bureau of Greater Monroeville and the Monroeville Senior Citizens Center.

SECTION 4 . All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
