ORDINANCE NO. 1685

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING COUNSEL TO ENTER INTO A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL SANITARY AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE A SANITARY SEWAGE TREATMENT SERVICE TO AREAS OF MONROEVILLE, INCLUDING THE SHANGRI-LA PLAN OF LOTS.

WHEREAS, the Franklin Township Municipal Sanitary Authority (hereinafter "FIMSA"), is operating a sanitary sewage collection facility and disposal plant in the Municipality of Murrysville and has been designated by the Municipality of Murrysville; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville has presently existing within its corporate boundaries a subdivision known as the "Shangri-La Plan of Lots" which is presently serviced by a sewage pump station and collection facility; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Municipality of Monroeville to abandon said sewage pump station, and to connect the Shangri-La area of the Municipality of Monroeville to the sanitary sewer lines of the FIMSA; and

WHEREAS, it is also the desire of Monroeville to connect various other areas within the corporate boundaries of Monroeville to the said sanitary sewage collection facility of FIMSA; and

WHEREAS, FIMSA is willing to provide a sanitary sewage treatment service to certain areas of Monroeville, including the area known as the Shangri-La Plan of Lots.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, Allegheny County, and it is hereby enacted by the Authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Franklin Township Municipal Sanitary Authority to provide a sanitary sewage treatment service to certain areas of Monroeville including the area known as the Shangri-La Plan of Lots. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto, and made a part hereof and marked as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. Any other Resolution or Ordinance or part of any Resolution or Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.


