ORDINANCE NO. 1691

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE PROPER MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE P.M.R.B. TO UPGRADE IT'S MEMBER BENEFITS AS AUTHORIZED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW; TO ASSUME ALL OBLIGATIONS PURSUANT TO SAID LAW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipality of Monroeville, being a member Municipality of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, hereby elects to upgrade its member benefits in that System as authorized by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, as amended, and does hereby agree to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of said Article and the Law, as the case may be, and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise, placed upon member municipalities by said Amendment, as the case may be. All references hereafter shall be based on benefits negotiated between the Board of the Municipality under the provisions of Article IV.

SECTION 2. Membership in the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System shall be mandatory for all permanent, municipal employees of the Municipality. Membership for elected officials and employees hired on a temporary or seasonal basis is prohibited, as is membership for individuals paid only on a fee basis.

SECTION 3. Credit for prior service for original employees is granted for each year or partial year thereof that the member was employed by the Municipality from original date of hire. Benefits provided to members in the Agreement dated October 1, 1989, shall accrue based on all credited service granted and earned in accordance with this Section.

The Municipality of Monroeville hereby assumes all liability for any unfundedness created due to the acceptance of the benefit structure outlined in the above-referenced Agreement.

SECTION 4. Payment for any obligation established by the adoption of this Ordinance and the Agreement between the System and the Municipality of Monroeville shall be made by the Municipality in accordance with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law and Act 205 of 1984, the Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standard and Recovery Act.

SECTION 5. As part of this Ordinance, the Municipality agrees that the System shall provide the benefits set forth in the Agreement between the passage and adoption of this Ordinance by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, dated October 1, 1989. The passage and adoption of this

Ordinance by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is an official acceptance of said Agreement and the financial obligations resulting from the administration of said benefit package.

SECTION 6. The Municipality hereby acknowledges that an affirmative vote representing at least seventy-five percent (75%) of all current plan members indicated the members were in agreement with the upgrade of the plan with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System.

SECTION 7. The Municipality of Monroeville intends this Ordinance to be the complete authorization of the municipal plan and, therefore, specifically repeals Resolution 82-41 of the Municipality of Monroeville.

SECTION 8. A duly certified copy of this Ordinance and the referenced Agreement shall be filed with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Membership for the municipal employees of the Municipality of Monroeville in the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System shall be effective the first day of September, 1982, with the upgraded plan structure reflected in the revised Agreement, dated October 1, 1989, effective the 1st day of October, 1989.
