ORDINANCE NO. 1698

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE
NO. 1527 AT SECTION 5, CHAPTER 201, ARTICLE I,
SECTION 1-105 AND ARTICLE III SECTION 3-02
SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 744;
AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF CUL-DE-SAC IN
SECTION 1-105 AND AMENDING THE CONDITIONS FOR
A CUL-DE-SAC IN SECTION 3-02.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Municipal Council of the Municipality
of Monroeville to eliminate cul-de-sac turn-arounds in the form of "T"
within the Municipality of Monroeville.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipality of Monroeville and it
is hereby ordained as follows:

SECTION 1: The Planning and Construction Code, Ordinance No. 1527 at
Section 5, Chapter 201, Article I, Section 1-05 (e) regarding Subdivision
Regulations of the Municipality of Monroeville is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1-05. Definitions

(e) "Cul-de-sac", a street intersecting another street
at one end, and terminating at the other in a circular
vehicular turn-around.

SECTION 2: The Planning and Construction Code, Ordinance No. 1527 at
Section 5, Chapter 201, Article III, Section 3-02 (1) (b) regarding
subdivision regulations of Ordinance No. 744 in the Municipality of
Monroeville is hereby amended as follows:

Section 3-02 Street Systems

(1) (b) It shall have an adequate turn-around, in a circular form with a radius of a minimum fifty (50) feet. Cul-de-sac streets for properties with topographic or other physical hardships service not more than twenty (20) housing units, may be permitted to have forty (40) feet right-of-way, provided the roadway, sidewalks, and slope areas are properly designated and spaced inside of the right-of-way.

SECTION 3: Any Ordinance or Resolution or part of any Ordinance or Resolution in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


