ORDINANCE NO. 1708

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1678 PROHIBITING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON ORCHARD ALLEY BETWEEN ELMWOOD DRIVE AND MONROEVILLE BOULEVARD; EXEMPTING POLICE, FIRE, AMBULANCE AND LOCAL RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, on September 12, 1989, the Municipality of Monroeville adopted Ordinance No. 1678 designating Orchard Alley as a one way vehicular roadway for traffic travelling in a westerly direction from Orchard Alley to Monroeville Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, for the protection of the health and safety of the residents of the Municipality of Monroeville it is essential that vehicular traffic be prohibited on Orchard Alley from Elmwood Avenue to Monroeville Boulevard and that only police, fire, including properly designated volunteer fire vehicles, ambulance emergency vehicles and local residents who require access to Orchard Alley be permitted access to Orchard Alley from Elmwood Drive to Monroeville Boulevard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1678 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. Orchard Alley, a vehicular public road running in a general east, west direction, shall hereinafter be designated as a non vehicular roadway for traffic from Elmwood Drive to Monroeville Boulevard in both a easterly and westerly direction. Said roadway shall be posted with appropriate signs indicating that vehicular traffic is prohibited.

However, to insure the health and safety of the residents of the Municipality of Monroeville, all police, fire, including properly designated volunteer fire vehicles and ambulance emergency vehicles shall be permitted to use Orchard Alley from Monroeville Boulevard to Elmwood Drive travelling in both a easterly and westerly direction, during emergency conditions. Furthermore, local residents who own property located at the intersection of Elmwood Drive and Orchard Alley and the property located at Orchard Alley and Monroeville Boulevard and whose only access to Orchard Alley shall be permitted the use of Orchard Alley at all times. The roadway shall be posted with proper signage to permit local access and local deliveries.


SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
