ORDINANCE NO. 1733

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE
1364 PROVIDING FOR THE REINSTITUTION OF A
BUSINESS LICENSE FEE PURSUANT TO ACT 511 OF 1965
AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1166 provided for the establishment of a business license fee in the amount of \$15.00; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1364 inadvertently removed the aforesaid license fee from Section 5, Subparagraph A, of Ordinance 899 as amended by Ordinance 1166; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of correcting said error.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council as assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 5, Subparagraph A, of Ordinance 899 as amended by Ordinances 1166 and 1364 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5. Returns, Regulations, License and Fees.

(A) Every person subject to the tax imposed by this ordinance shall forthwith register with the Municipal Manager and set forth his name, address, business address and the nature of the business activity in which he is engaged. For each tax year or part thereof which any person is engaged in business in the Municipality of Monroeville, the Municipality shall issue a business privilege license in the manner and for the fees as hereinafter set forth. Beginning in the tax year 1979, each person desiring to continue to engage in business in Monroeville, whether the same be


incidental to some other business or occupation shall, prior to commencing business in any tax year, procure a business privilege tax license for his or her place of business, or if more than one (1), for each of his or her places of business in Monroeville, from the Municipal Manager who shall issue the same upon the payment of a fee of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars. Such license shall be conspicuously posted in the place of business of each of the places of business of every such person at all times. No person engaging in any business who has procured a mercantile tax license for a related business activity shall be required to procure this business privilege license.

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or Resolution or part of any Ordinance or Resolution in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.


