ORDINANCE NO. 1738

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
AMENDING SECTION II OF ORDINANCE NO. 1298 PROVIDING
FOR AN INCREASE IN TAX ON SALARIES, WAGES, COMMISSIONS,
COMPENSATION AND EARNED INCOME AND ESTABLISHING TAX
ON THE WAGES, SALARIES, COMMISSIONS, COMPENSATION AND
EARNED INCOME FROM 1.2% TO 1.5%.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipality of Monroeville, in Council assembled as follows under the provisions of Act No. 511 known as the Local Tax Enabling Act and Act 62 known as the Home Rule Charter Plans Act.

Section 1. The provisions of Ordinance No. 1298 are hereby re-enacted except as herein amended.

Section 2. Section II of Ordinance No. 1298 shall be amended to read as follows:

"Section II Imposition of Tax

A. Tax under the local Tax Enabling Act: The tax levied under this Ordinance shall be applicable to earned income received and to net profits earned in the period beginning January 1st and ending December 31st of the year 1991, and the tax shall continue in force on a calendar year basis, without annual re-enactment, unless the rate of the tax is subsequently changed. Changes in rate shall become effective on the date specified in the Ordinance. Under provisions of Act 511, the Local Tax Enabling Act the tax is herewith levied at the rate of one percent (1%) on earned income and net profits as provided for in the definition herein of earned income and net profits, it being acknowledged that as of the date of this ordinance the Gateway School District collects .5% of this 1% tax and the Municipality of Monroeville collects .5% of the said tax.

B. Tax Under the Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Act: In addition to the tax levied in Section 1 hereof there is hereby levied under the provisions of Act 62 of the Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Act, a tax at the rate of five-tenths (.5%) percent on earned income and net profits as provided for in the definitions herein of earned income and net profits."

Ordinance No. 1738

Section 3: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
