ORDINANCE NO. 1758

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 235, AS AMENDED, ESTABLISHING A BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MONROEVILLE LIBRARY CONSISTING OF SEVEN (7) MEMBERS AND ONE (1) EX-OFFICIO MEMBER; PROHIBITING MORE THAN ONE (1) PERSON FROM EACH WARD FROM SITTING AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 235 is inconsistent with the language contained in the Home Rule Charter in that it does not specifically indicate that the Board of Directors of the Monroeville Library shall consist of seven (7) members and one (1) member of Council who shall sit in an ex-officio capacity; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of amending Ordinance No. 235 to comply with the language contained in Article XVIII Sections 1802(c) and 1808 of the Home Rule Charter of the Municipality of Monroeville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 235 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. CREATION AND COMPOSITION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

There is hereby created and established, in the Municipality of Monroeville, the Board of Directors of the Monroeville Library, which shall have full and complete control over the operation and conduct of a municipal library including the effort to get such a library established.

The Board shall consist of seven (7) members each of whom shall be a bona fide resident of the Municipality of Monroeville. One member of the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville shall sit in an ex-officio capacity as a representative of the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville.

No more than one (1) person from each Ward of the Municipality of Monroeville shall sit as a member of the Board of Directors of the Monroeville Library. The current members of the Board of Directors shall be permitted to fulfill their terms without being in violation of this provision, however, upon the expiration of the terms of the current members, the vacancies shall be filled so that no more than one (1) member from each Ward of the Municipality shall be represented on the Board of Directors.

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
