ORDINANCE NO. 1765

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 306, SITE PLAN REVIEW, OF THE MONROEVILLE ZONING ORDINANCE, 1443, AS AMENDED, PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF STREET TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, STREET NAME SIGNS, TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL DEVICES; PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF PRE-EMPTIVE TRAFFIC SIGNAL EQUIPMENT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of amending its Zoning Ordinance to establish consistent rules and regulations in regard to street name signs, traffic control signs and other traffic control signals and devices to provide a consistent, efficient and safe street traffic control system within the Municipality of Monroeville; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville has determined that an important component of the street traffic control system should be an emergency vehicle pre-emption system; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of establishing a consistent, efficient and safe traffic control device system containing the ability for installation of an emergency vehicle pre-emption system.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 306 of Ordinance 1443, as amended, the Zoning Ordinance of the Municipality of Monroeville, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 306.5(k). Street Traffic Control Devices.


1. All street name signs, traffic control signs and other traffic control devices as deemed necessary by the Municipality shall be provided and erected by the applicant.
2. All street name signs shall conform to and be erected as per the Municipality of Monroeville's specifications for street name signs.
3. All traffic control signs shall be Pennsylvania Department of Transportation approved, conformed to applicable regulations and be placed using heavy duty breakaway channel posts (or equal as approved by the Municipality).
4. All other traffic control devices shall be Municipal approved and conform to Pennsylvania Department of Transportation as well as all other applicable regulations, including any federal or county regulations promulgated for specific projects.
5. All traffic signals shall have pre-emptive equipment provided and erected by the applicant.


SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or Resolution or part of any Ordinance or Resolution in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
