ORDINANCE NO. 1767

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION
1 OF ORDINANCE 1410 REDEFINING "SOLICITOR"

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the
Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1. The definition of "Solicitor" in Section 1, entitled,
"Definitions" of Ordinance 1410 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. Definitions:


"Solicitor" shall include any person:

- (a) who goes from private house to private house, conveying or transporting goods, wares or merchandise or offering or exposing the same for sale or making sales or delivering articles, goods, wares or merchandise to purchasers;
- (b) who goes from private house to private house, soliciting or attempting to take orders from individuals for sale of goods, wares or merchandise, including magazines, books, periodicals or personal property of any nature whatsoever, for future delivery, or for service to be performed at that time or in the future, whether or not such individual has, carries or exposes for sale a sample of the subject of such order or whether or not he is collecting advance payments on such orders;
- (c) who goes from private house to private house, business to business or parking lot to parking lot, disseminating any written information for themselves or for any organization for any purpose, soliciting donations or moneys for themselves or for any organization for any purpose, whether or not anything of value is given in return.


SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
