ORDINANCE NO. 1768

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,  
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION  
210 OF ORDINANCE 1443 INCREASING THE HEIGHT OF  
CERTAIN FENCES FROM THREE (3) TO FOUR (4) FEET

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Municipal Council of  
the Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the  
authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 210 of Ordinance 1443 is hereby amended to read  
as follows:

SUBSECTION 210. FENCES: A fence may be erected into any required  
side or rear yard if the fence is no more than six (6) feet in height for  
residential uses. A fence which is at least fifty (50%) percent open as to  
construction and which is no more than four (4) feet high may be erected in  
any required residential front yard.


SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict  
herewith is hereby repealed.
