ORDINANCE NO. 1799


AND NOW, on May 12, 1992, it is ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Municipal Council of the Municipality of Monroeville as follows:

SECTION 1. Old William Penn Highway, a vehicular public road running in a general southeasterly direction, shall hereinafter be designated as a one way vehicular roadway for traffic travelling on Old William Penn Highway in a southeasterly direction beginning at a point approximately 1200 linear feet from the intersection of Old William Penn Highway and the Route 286 ramp to the intersection of Old William Penn Highway and the Route 286 ramp to Route 22 west. Said roadway shall be posted with the appropriate signs indicating "ONE WAY TRAFFIC" only and appropriate "DO NOT ENTER" signs at the intersection of Old William Penn Highway and the Route 286 ramp.


SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
