ORDINANCE NO. 1800

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE
1797, PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A GRAFFITI
REWARD ACCOUNT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING REWARDS
FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE
1797 AND ESTABLISHING PUBLIC AWARENESS PROGRAMS

NOW, THEREFORE, on June 9, 1992, BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the
Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and
enacted as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1797 is hereby amended to add the following
provisions:

SECTION 6. Rewards - Graffiti Reward Account


- a.) The Municipal Manager is hereby authorized and directed to
establish a special account known as the Graffiti Reward
Account for the receipt and deposit of private sector
contributions and the fines resulting from violations of this
Chapter. Said funds shall be used specifically for rewards
and public awareness programs.
- b.) The Municipal Manager shall grant rewards up to the sum of
Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars to individuals, organizations
or other entities who provide information leading to the
arrest and/or conviction of any individual for violating the
provisions of this Ordinance.
- c.) Said rewards shall be granted from the Graffiti Reward
Account.

SECTION 2. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict
herewith is hereby repealed.


