ORDINANCE NO. 1810

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING THE
PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 1610, ELIMINATING
THE TAX FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES IMPOSED ON
THE OPERATORS OF LANDFILL OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville adopted Ordinance No. 1610 pursuant to the Local Tax Enabling Act, Act of 1965, P. L. 1257, which provided for the imposition of a tax in the amount of \$1.50 per ton on disposable material brought to the site of any landfill operation;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of repealing said Ordinance to benefit and stimulate commercial and residential development in the Municipality of Monroeville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, and IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED as follows:


SECTION 1. The Council of the Municipality of Monroeville hereby repeals the provisions of Ordinance No. 1610 which imposed a tax for general revenue purposes of \$1.50 per ton on disposable material, as defined by Ordinance No. 1610. The tax for general revenue purposes was enacted under the Authority of the Local Tax Enabling Act, Act of 1965, P. L. 1257. No. 511.


SECTION 2. The repeal of the provisions of Ordinance No. 1610 is effective as of the effective date of this Ordinance.
