ORDINANCE NO. 1842

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REQUESTING THE ALLEGHENY COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO PLACE ON THE NOVEMBER 2, 1993 BALLOT AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION C-109(A) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES, THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE HOME RULE CHARTER; PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITION OF TWO MEMBERS TO THE MONROEVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION, INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF SAID COMMISSION FROM FIVE TO SEVEN AND SETTING THE TERMS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Section 202 of the Municipalities Planning Code, provides for a 3 to 9 member Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Council of the Municipality of Monroeville is desirous of increasing the Planning Commission Membership from 5 to 7 in the interest of the welfare of the Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The Allegheny County Board of Elections is hereby requested to place on the 1993 General Ballot for consideration and approval by the electors of the Municipality of Monroeville an amendment to Section C-109(A) of the Municipality of Monroeville Code of Ordinances, Home Rule Charter providing for the addition of two members to the Monroeville Planning Commission, increasing the membership of said Commission from five to seven and setting the terms therefor.

SECTION 2. The proposed Amendment to Section C-109(A) of the Code of Ordinances, Home Rule Charter is as follows:

Subsection C-109 Planning Commission

- A. The Planning Commission shall consist of seven (7) residents of the Municipality. The term of each of the members of the commission shall be for four years, or until his successor is appointed and qualified, except that the terms of the members shall be so fixed that no more than two (2) shall be reappointed or replaced during any future calendar year. Members of the Commission shall hold no other elective office of the Municipality. The Commission may make and alter rules and regulations for its own organization and procedure, consistent with the Ordinances of the Municipality and general law.


SECTION 3. Any cost for printing the ballot, advertisement or incidental to this Special Election as required by the County of Allegheny, Board of Elections shall be paid by the Municipality.


SECTION 4. The Municipality shall immediately transmit this Ordinance to the Allegheny County Board of Elections, County Office Building, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, upon its enactment and the Solicitor shall provide any additional information required by the Board of Elections.
