ORDINANCE NO. 1850

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY
OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
REPEALING THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 1534

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville and American Cablevision entered into a Franchise Agreement providing for the assessment of a franchise fee in the amount of three (3) percent of the revenues generated by the cable company; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville attempted to unilaterally increase the amount of the franchise fee from three (3) percent to five (5) percent pursuant to Ordinance No. 1534; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville entered into litigation with American Cable, Inc., concerning the issue of the franchise fee; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Monroeville and American Cable, Inc., entered into a Settlement Agreement wherein the Municipality of Monroeville agreed to keep the franchise fee at three (3) percent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1534 is hereby repealed. The provisions increasing the cable television franchise fee from three (3) percent to five (5) percent are specifically repealed retroactively to June 10, 1986.

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.


