ORDINANCE NO. 1852

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A SIX HUNDRED AND FIFTY (650) FOOT NO PARKING ZONE ON THE WEST SIDE OF ROUTE 48, SOUTH OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH OLD WILLIAM PENN HIGHWAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the Municipality has the authority to prohibit stopping, standing or parking and set penalties for violations under 75 Pa. C.S.A. Subsection 6109 (a) (1) and Subsection 6301, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality is desirous of securing the health and safety of its citizens by eliminating unsafe traffic conditions; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the regulation of traffic on U.S. Route 48, in the Third Ward, is being impeded by the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles on that street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of Monroeville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Definitions.

The following words and phrases when used in this title shall have, unless the content clearly indicates otherwise, the following meanings:

- 1.) "Park" or "Parking". The halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers.
- 2.) "Stand" or "Standing". The halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in receiving or discharging passengers.
- 3.) "Stop" or "Stopping". Any halting, even momentarily, of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a Police Officer or traffic-control sign or signal.

SECTION 2. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, all parking, standing, or stopping of motor vehicles on U.S. Route 48 shall be prohibited as follows:

A.) All parking, standing or stopping of motor vehicles shall be prohibited for a distance of six hundred fifty (650) feet on the west side of U. S. Route 48, south of its intersection with Old William Penn Highway by the placement of signage designating NO PARKING.


The Municipality shall erect the proper signage prohibiting the parking, standing or stopping of motor vehicles at the aforesaid designated areas.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
