ORDINANCE NO. 1870

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE
CONTINUING THE DEED TRANSFER TAX, OCCUPATIONAL
PRIVILEGE TAX, MERCANTILE TAX, AND BUSINESS
PRIVILEGE TAX PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL TAX ENABLING
ACT OF 1965, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Municipality of Monroeville, in
Council assembled as follows:

SECTION 1. The following taxes, enacted pursuant to the Local
Tax Enabling Act of 1965, as amended, also known as Act No. 511, are of
continuing effect for 1994.


Deed Transfer Tax; (at one percent 1%)
Occupational Privilege Tax; (\$10.00 per person)
Mercantile Tax; and (at two mills wholesale and 2.5 mills retail)
Business Privilege Tax (at 4 mills)

SECTION 2. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict
herewith is hereby repealed.
