BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Municipality of
Monroeville as follows:

Section 1: ADOPTION OF FIRE PREVENTION CODE

That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file
in the office of the Manager of the Municipality of Monroeville,
being marked and designated as "The BOCA Basic Fire Prevention
Code, 7th edition, 1987", as published by the Building Officials
and Code Administrators International, Inc. is hereby adopted as
the Fire Prevention Code of the Municipality of Monroeville in the
State of Pennsylvania; for the control of buildings and structures
as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations,
provisions, penalties, conditional and terms of said BOCA Basic
Fire Prevention Code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a
part thereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance with the
addition, deletions, or changes, if any, prescribed in Section 3 of
this ordinance.

Section 2: INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED

That Ordinance Number 1325 Section 2 of the Municipality of
Monroeville entitled Ordinance 1325 Section 2 an ordinance amending
ordinance 829 as amended, and all other ordinances or parts of
ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: ADDITIONS, INSERTIONS AND CHANGES

These regulations as set forth herein shall be known as the Fire Prevention Code of Monroeville and herein referred to as such or as "this code."

Section 4: SAVING CLAUSE

That nothing in this ordinance or in the Fire Prevention Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any Court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinances hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 5: PENALTY CLAUSE


Any person who shall violate a provision of this ordinance or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements hereof, who shall erect, construct, alter, install or discontinue a fire protection device or implement, shall be in violation of the provisions of this code or directive of the Fire Official, or of a permit or certificate issued under the provisions of this code, shall be guilty of a summary offense, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment not exceeding sixty (60) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 6: DATE OF EFFECT

That the office of the Manager shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately after the date of final passage and approval.
