

BEFORE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY)
OF MONROEVILLE AMENDING SECTION 2)
AND SECTION 7, OF ORDINANCE NO. 900) ORDINANCE NO. 1977
KNOWN AS THE MECHANICAL DEVICE)
ORDINANCE AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES)
FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF)

AN NOW, on April 9, 1996, Municipal Council of the Municipality of Monroeville hereby ORDAINS AND ENACTS as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 900 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Any person or persons, firm or corporation, desiring to procure a license as provided in Section 1 of Ordinance 900 shall apply therefore on or Before March 15th of each year in writing to the Manager of the Municipality. Said application shall set forth the name or names, the residence or residences of the person or persons, firm or corporation, so applying to either with the present and previous occupation of the applicant and the length of residence at the present place of residence, the exact name of the owner of the premises upon which said machine or machines are to be installed and if the owner of the premises is not the applicant, then the applicant shall set forth the length of time which the premises have been leased or otherwise occupied and whether the applicant is a citizen of the United States of America. The applicant shall also set forth the description, kind and nature of the machine or machines to be installed and used. The information required by this section shall be furnished over the signature or signatures of the applicant or applicants and shall be verified by oath and affirmation.

SECTION 2. Section 7 of Ordinance 900 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 7. Upon payment of the license fee as provided by this ordinance, the Municipal Manager of the Municipality shall issue a sticker setting forth the number of the permit for each machine so licensed, the date of issue and the kind and nature of the machine so licensed, which sticker shall be attached to machine or device so permitted, in such manner that the same may be at all times clearly observable and readable.

SECTION 3. Any persons or persons, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction before the District Magistrate for the Municipality of Monroeville be subject to a fine of not less than Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollars and not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars, for each offense, or be sentenced and committed to the County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days. Each and every day that any machines, as


provided under the terms of this Ordinance, shall be operated and used in violation thereof, shall constitute a separate and distinct offense and shall be subject to separate and distinct penalties thereon.

SECTION 4. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance in conflict herewith is repealed.


